How to apply

All students are welcomed to apply for the PORG International School. Applications must be made using the official [application form](#), or [online](#).

Application form for admission to the PORG International School is available on our website, upon request via e-mail or at principal's office.

PORG International School is a selective school which welcomes children from all backgrounds and offers education for children aged 5 -11. For every class (Years 1 - 6) we admit a maximum of 16 pupils.

We can accept children anytime during the school year as long as there are free places in the class.

Application to PORG International School includes the following:

- Attend a pre-admission interview with the Head of the school.
- Complete the online Student Application form through the school website.
- To proceed with the online application, please visit the PORG International School website and complete the Application Form by clicking on Apply Now.
- Signed Data Protection Consent Form (GDPR).
- Pay the registration fee of 5000 CZK.
- Child's enrolment participation.

The admission fee is not refundable in the case of application withdrawal.

Other documents are needed before signing the Agreement.

- Copy of student's and parents' passports (for foreigners).
- Copy of visa (for foreigners).
- Copy of birth certificate (for Czech citizens).
- Reports or transcripts from the last school.

Tuition and Fees

The registration fee is a part of the admission process. The amount of the registration fee is 5000 CZK.

The Tuition Fee for the first school year is CZK 351,900. The Tuition Fee for each year is paid in two equal instalments. The first instalment falls due on 15 August prior to the start of the school year and the second instalment on 31 January of current school year. All instalments of the Tuition Fee must be made as wire transfer to the School's account. Tuition & Fees are payable in full based on the due date. It is the responsibility of the parent or guardian to ensure payments are made when due and to inform the school promptly of any billing address changes. Placement is not guaranteed until full tuition and fee payments are paid.

At the moment, the school gives 10% discount to parents of siblings. The school fee includes and provides the student with study materials, books, text books and exercise books. The school fee also covers expenses for extra events and activities. Expenses for meals, uniforms, trips and camps are not included in the school tuition fee.

In cases where students are suspended or dismissed for unsatisfactory conduct or academic progress, all tuition and fees paid are non-refundable.

All financial terms and conditions as well as conditions of termination are listed in Agreement of Study.

Enrolment

The School welcomes children from many different ethnic groups and backgrounds. Human rights and freedoms are respected but must be balanced with the lawful needs and rules of the School community and the rights and freedoms of others. All candidates for admission will be treated equally, irrespective of their, or their parents', race, colour, language, religion, political or other opinion, national or social origin, association with a national minority, orientation, property, birth or other status.

As soon as the parents of the prospective pupil complete and return the Application Form to our school, they will be provided with a response from school together with the invitation to complete the entrance exams and interview. The entrance exams for the pupils consist of English and Mathematics papers. The Principal of the school takes the final decision on acceptance. The process usually takes a couple of days. We will

contact the parents of prospective pupil with the result immediately upon the completion of a process.

Parents should be aware that there are uniform requirements. Sport, swimming and fitness activities are compulsory, and classes are not always segregated by gender.

Additional information

Parents must as soon as possible disclose any particular-known or suspected circumstances relating to their child's health, allergies, physical and mental impairment disabilities, learning difficulties or disabilities or special educational needs.

If the School has to decide between two or more candidates who meet the School's admission requirements after all appropriate allowances and special consideration has been given, the School may give preference to:

- a child who already has a brother or sister in the school;
- a child whose parent is current member of the School teaching staff;
- a child with a particular skill, talent or aptitude.
